Road Safety Audits

Overview

Road Safety Audits are a pro-active approach to road safety, forming an integral part of the safe system approach at all stages of the road construction and maintenance process.

IPWEAQ is offering a two-day workshop that has been developed to provide attendees with the knowledge and skills required when conducting or responding to a Road Safety Audit. This program will work through the Austroads Guide to Road Safety Part 6: Road Safety Audit, utilising case studies and practical exercises including day and night time inspections that will provide practitioners and decision-makers with ways to formally address road safety issues before accidents occur.
